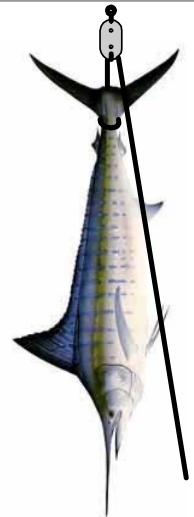
FISHERMAN'S LANDING TACKLE DAYS
