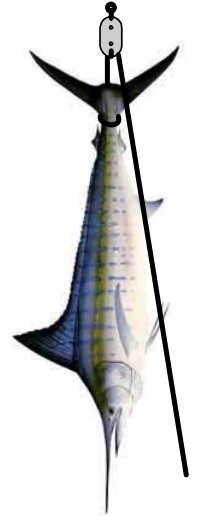
THE WEIGHMASTER'S REPORT
