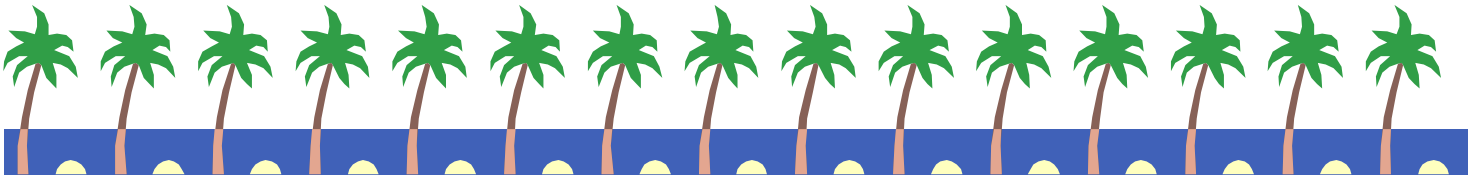
Since we now have a burgee, I thought that I would do a reminder on flag etiquette. The Club flag flies when the club is attended, a marlin flag is attached at half mast when the club has been notified that a marlin is coming in to be weighed. When the boat turns to back into the weigh station, the cannon is fired (Oh, yes, the cannon has been repaired and we have permission from the SDPD to use it!) and the marlin flag is flown beneath the burgee. This is repeated for all fish weighed in that day or Tag & Released that day. For boats, you may fly the appropriate flags (s) after the capture until the next time your boat leaves the slip to fish. So don't continue to fly a flag for the fish you caught Monday if you went out Tuesday and got skunked!

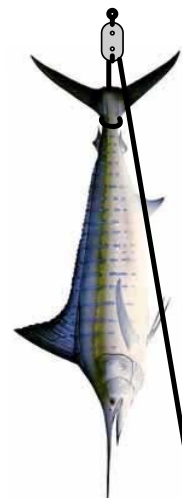

MBMC YELLOWTAIL TOURNAMENT ENTRY FORM

JULY 15TH, 2006

Entry fees are \$15.00 per MBMC member, & \$20.00 per guest. An optional \$5.00 cash jackpot fee will be collected from those who wish to participate. The heaviest single Yellowtail of the tournament will collect the optional jackpot.

Saturday July 15th, 2006, fishing starts at 12:01 AM and continues until you can make the weigh in at 6:00 PM at the Dana Landing dock. You must be in the Dana Landing Basin and be visible from the weigh-in dock by 6:00 pm. Since this is a one day tournament, fish may be weighed in by Dana Landing personnel no later than 10:00 am on Sunday July 16th, 2006.

Tournament entry fees & forms will be collected at Dana Landing Market & Fuel Dock. All entries must be submitted by 8:00 pm on Friday July 14th, 2006 at Dana Landing, in person, or faxed to the tournament chairman at 858-459-1011.

In the event of weather conditions and/or any other potential reason to cancel or postpone the tournament, a message will be left on the MBMC message machine at 619-224-8862. The decision will be made by the board no later than 9:00 pm the day before the tournament and put on the message machine as well as posted on the web site. Please check either the message line and/or the web site if conditions look questionable. M.B. Lifeguard current weather conditions and warnings can be heard at 619-221-8824.

YELLOWTAIL TOURNAMENT RULES

1. Tournament will be one day, commencing Saturday, JULY 15th, 2006 @ 12:01 AM and ending @ 6:00 PM.
2. Tournament entry fees will be collected at Dana Landing Market and Fuel Dock. All entries must be submitted by 8:00 PM Friday JULY 14th, 2006 at Dana Landing, in person, or faxed to the tournament chairman at 858-459-1011.
3. **All entries not paid at time of sign-up must be paid in full by 6:00 pm on Saturday, to be eligible for the tournament.**
4. Fishing area is from San Martin Island to the south and San Miguel Island to the north.
5. I.G.F.A. rules will apply to tackle and method of take.
6. Weigh in time is from 12:00 PM to 6:00 PM on Saturday. You must be in the Dana Landing Basin and be visible from the weigh-in dock by 6:00 PM. In addition, fish may be weighed in on Sunday, no later 10:00am.
7. Top boat shall be decided by the boat with the HEAVIEST WEIGHT of their top 3 fish of the tournament species. The species targeted in this tournament is Yellowtail.
8. Scoring: 4 points for first place, 3 for second, 2 for third, and one point for a fish weighed in of the targeted species. These points accumulate for all MBMC tournaments open to all members for the angling year 2006. A maximum of 8 tournaments will determine the total score for each angler and boat. A minimum of 5 tournaments during the year must be fished to be in contention for the top boat or angler.
9. Payouts for first, second, and third overall heaviest target fish will be based on a percentage of the total amount of entry fees collected.
10. Radio Communications will be on Channel 69. The club and other boats can be contacted on this channel.
11. You are responsible for having all the necessary California Fishing Licenses and Mexican Fishing Permits when fishing California and/or Mexican waters. You should also be aware of the laws governing the number and size of fish in your possession.
12. All protests must be received in writing no later than one hour after final weigh-in and will be reviewed by the Protest Committee for validity.
13. Tournament results will be posted soon after final weigh-in on Saturday. Awards will be presented at the next social event if not sooner.
