May already. Time is going by very fast. Only four Months until the Heart Tournament. Due to this we are intending to meet with Al Pitcairn on Wednesday 14 May 2008 at 1800. All interested in helping are invited.

April saw our Ling Cod and Bottomfish Tournament with fairly good weather and great participation. Lots of both varieties were weighed in. I personally found that I had removed a valuable asset from the Lively Ones electronic inventory. I had replaced the old Lowrance Globalmap with the new Lowrance Globalmap. I figured all the spots were saved as waypoints and I could just transfer them by hand. Wrong! The old Globalmap had a Position Correction Factor (PCF) that made the map line up with position from the GPS. This put in a 100 yard Easterly error on all my waypoints. I could not find my Ling Cod spots even though the GPS said I was right on top of them. I know the new ones are prettier and easier to use but there is a lot of information on those units you have been using for years.

I corrected this for the Rockfish Tournament by putting the old one back on the boat. We found the spots (even the Ling Cod spot) but besides finding them you got to be able to catch them as well. All the rockfish we caught were under five pounds but we had several between 4 and 5 pounds. Great job to all the winners.

Speaking of winners, take a look at our website. www.missionbaymarlinclub.org Our Charlie Watson has revamped the front page and it really looks good. The web has the results right there on the last tournament and we are working to make this a really good site for members information. There have been some suggestions from the membership and some commitments to updating the web frequently to keep it current.

If you have any ideas or some questions about use of the website let someone on the board know your concerns or questions.

There have been some volunteers for the Tournament Director position as temporary replacements for a month or two. This help is very much appreciated but for consistency and a permanent replacement would help us out a lot. The Club has this months Halibut and White Seabass tournament coming up on May 17 and 18. We also have the seminar on May 16th at Marina Village Conference Center. Tournament Entry Forms are also on the Web on the Tournament Page.

A couple of boats have made some nice mackerel baits at the docks there at Marina Village. Might be good to have a lucky joe available during your boat visits. Also there have been some Thresher caught recently. I actually saw a Thresher jump between the boats on the South end of the Nine Mile Bank on the Rockfish Tournament. One of the many boats on the South end of the Nine caught that shark a couple of hours later and released it. Time to rinse the Winter dust off the boats and get to fishing.

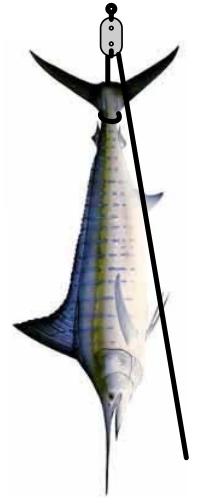

MBMC HALIBUT-WHITE SEA BASS TOURNAMENT ENTRY FORM

MAY 17th & 18th, 2008

Entry fees are \$15.00 per MBMC member, \$20.00 per guest. An optional \$5.00 cash jackpot fee will be collected from those who wish to participate. The heaviest single Halibut or White Sea Bass of the tournament will collect the optional jackpot.

Saturday May 17th 2008, fishing starts at 12:01 AM and continues until you can make the weigh in at 6:00 PM at the Dana Landing dock. Fish not weighed in by the 6:00 PM deadline on Saturday may be weighed in Sunday when the scales are open.

Sunday May 18th, 2008, fishing continues for this tournament and final weigh-in's are required no later than 6:00PM at the Dana Landing dock.

Tournament entry fees will be collected at Dana Landing Market & Fuel Dock. All entries must be submitted by 8:00 pm, Friday May 16th, 2008 at Dana Landing, in person, or faxed to the tournament chairman at 858-272-8697

By signing this application the applicant and their crew assumes all risk of injury, and/or property damage and does agree to hold Dana Landing Market and Fuel Dock, or the Marlin Club harmless should any injury or damage occur.

In the event of weather conditions and/or any other potential reason to cancel or postpone the tournament, a message will be left on the MBMC message machine at 619-224-8862. The decision will be made by the board no later than 9:00 pm the day before the tournament and put on the message machine as well as posted on the web site. Please check either the message line and/or the web site if conditions look questionable.

MBMC Halibut-White Sea Bass Tournament Rules

1. Tournament will be two days, commencing Saturday, May 17, 2008 @ 12:01 AM and ending @ 6:00 PM Sunday May 18, 2008. All participants are eligible to fish either or both days.
2. Tournament entry fees will be collected at Dana Landing Market and Fuel Dock. All entries must be submitted by 8:00 PM, Friday May 16, 2008 at Dana Landing, or in person.
3. **All entries not paid at time of sign-up must be paid in full by 6:00 PM, on Sunday, May 6th to remain eligible for the tournament.**
4. Fishing area is from San Martin Island to the south and San Miguel Island to the north.
5. I.G.F.A. rules will apply to tackle and method of take.
6. Weigh in time is from 12:00 PM to 6:00 PM Saturday and 12:00PM to 6:00PM Sunday. You must be in the Dana Landing Basin and be visible from the weigh-in dock by 6:00 PM.
7. Top boat shall be decided by the boat with the HEAVIEST WEIGHT of their top 3 fish of the tournament species. The species targeted in this tournament are halibut and white sea bass.
8. Radio Communications will be on Channel 69. The club and other boats can be contacted on this channel.
9. Scoring: 4 points for first place angler with heaviest target fish, 3 for second, 2 for third, and one point for a fish weighed in of the targeted species. These points accumulate for all MBMC tournaments open to all members for the angling year 2008. A maximum of 9 tournaments will determine the total score for each angler and boat. A minimum of 5 tournaments during the year must be fished to be in contention for the top boat or angler.
10. You are responsible for having all the necessary California Fishing Licenses and Mexican Fishing Permits when fishing California and/or Mexican waters. You should also be aware of the laws governing the number and size of fish in your possession.
11. All protests must be received in writing no later than one hour after final weigh-in and will be reviewed by the Protest Committee for validity.
12. Tournament results will be posted soon after final weigh in on Sunday. Awards will be presented at the next social event.
13. Payouts for first, second, and third place will be based on a percentage of the total amount of entry fees collected.
