I had very little luck as I insisted that I was going to fish bait. As our speaker, Doug Kern, pointed out, "if you are not snagging frequently you are not fishing in the right place." Well I was fishing in the right place but spent entirely too much time rigging and too little time fishing. I think the bait managed to scare away the Bass. I was also impressed by the knots that the bait could tie using just the kelp and their mouths.

I know of several boats making the run to the Albacore and Bluefin Tuna. They are reported to be within the normal run of 60 to 90 miles. The Lively One has gotten a fresh oil change and a turbo and injector change so I am ready. I am hoping for a wide open Tuna bite so I can finally catch a fish. It seems Tom Dow on the Hasta La Vista has gotten the first Albacore and Tuna flags for 2009. Congratulations to him and his crew for getting out there and getting them.

July is the Luau month. We are going all out for this one and are relying on a good participation to make this work. Please get your RSVP in and also mail in your moneys. Several people have worked hard to make this fun so please try to be there.

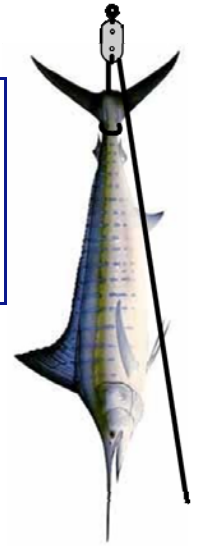
Have a great Summer and Fourth of July. Make some memories that will last a lifetime. Let's go fishing.

Hasta La Vista takes 1st Tuna & Albacore Flags for 2009

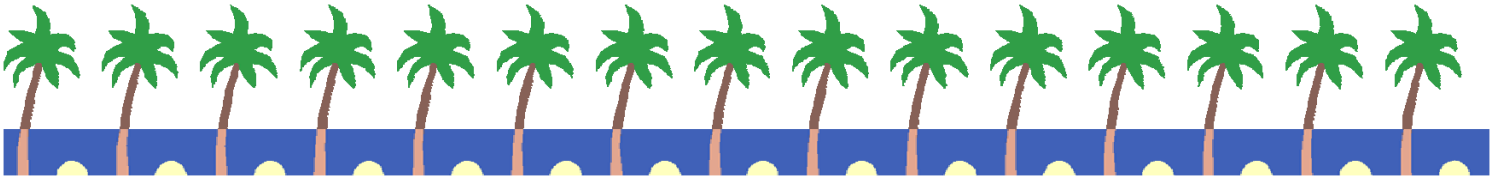


On June 23rd we headed down to the 295. Trolled south & east below the 295 and west of the 238 and got two triples at 31 32 N and 117 20 W.

In the PM, we headed north to 31 48 N and 117 06 W, about 10 miles for nothing and decided to give up and paddy hop on the way home. Then pulling in the outriggers we got a double, and one more single in that area while working temp breaks and marking fish at 20 feet. Then around sunset we saw birds crashing, trolled through it and landed the 28 # blue fin on the troll.

JULY 25th & 26th, 2009

Entry fees are \$15.00 per MBMC member, & \$20.00 per guest. An optional \$5.00 cash jackpot fee will be collected from those who wish to participate. The heaviest single Yellowtail of the tournament will collect the optional jackpot.

Saturday July 25, 2009 fishing starts at 12:01 AM and continues until you can make the weigh in at 6:00 PM at the Dana Landing dock. Fish not weighed in by the 6:00 pm deadline on Saturday may be weighed in on Sunday when the scales are open. Fishing continues Sunday, July 26, 2009 for this tournament and final weigh-in's are required no later than 6:00 pm at the Dana Landing Dock.

Tournament entry fees & forms will be collected at Dana Landing Market & Fuel Dock. All entries must be submitted by 8:00 pm on Friday July 24, 2009 at Dana Landing, or in person at the Seminar.

In the event of weather conditions and/or any other potential reason to cancel or postpone the tournament, a message will be left on the MBMC message machine at 619-224-8862. The decision will be made by the board no later than 9:00 pm the day before the tournament and put on the message machine as well as posted on the web site. Please check either the message line and/or the web site if conditions look questionable. M.B. Lifeguard current weather conditions and warnings can be heard at 619-221-8824.

2009 YELLOWTAIL TOURNAMENT RULES

1. Tournament will be two days, commencing Saturday, July 25, 2009 @ 12:01 AM and ending Sunday, July 26, 2009 @ 6:00 PM. All participants are eligible to fish either or both days.
2. Tournament entry fees will be collected at Dana Landing Market and Fuel Dock. All entries must be submitted by 6:00 PM Friday July 24, 2009 at Dana Landing, or in person at the Friday Night Seminar July 24th.
3. **All entries not paid at time of sign-up must be paid in full by 6:00 pm on Sunday, to be eligible for the tournament.**
4. Fishing area is from San Martin Island to the south and San Miguel Island to the north.
5. I.G.F.A. rules will apply to tackle and method of take.
6. Weigh in time is from 12:00 PM to 6:00 PM on Saturday and 12:00 pm to 6:00 pm Sunday. You must be in the Dana Landing Basin and be visible from the weigh-in dock by 6:00 PM.
7. Top boat shall be decided by the boat with the HEAVIEST WEIGHT of their top 3 fish of the tournament species. The species targeted in this tournament is **Yellowtail**.
8. Scoring: 4 points for first place, 3 for second, 2 for third, and one point for a fish weighed in of the targeted species. These points accumulate for all MBMC tournaments open to all members for the angling year 2008. A maximum 8 of 9 tournaments will determine the total score for each angler and boat. A minimum of 5 tournaments during the year must be fished to be in contention for the top boat or angler.
9. Payouts for first, second, and third overall heaviest target fish will be based on a percentage of the total amount of entry fees collected.
10. Radio Communications will be on Channel 69. The club and other boats can be contacted on this channel.
11. You are responsible for having all the necessary California Fishing Licenses and Mexican Fishing Permits when fishing California and/or Mexican waters.
12. All protests must be received in writing no later than one hour after final weigh-in and will be reviewed by the Protest Committee for validity.
13. Tournament results will be posted soon after final weigh-in on Saturday. Awards will be presented at the next social event if not sooner.
14. **Optional Cash Jackpot:** A voluntary \$5 cash jackpot per person entry is available to enter, however all anglers fishing on the same boat except Junior Anglers must be entered in order to qualify for the winner-take-all largest fish cash jackpot.
