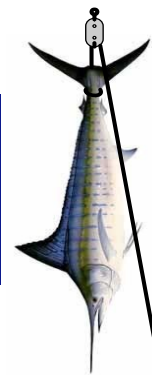

THE 2010 ROY LIVELY MONTH-LONG MARLIN TOURNAMENT

September 1 – September 30, 2010

Entry fees are \$50.00 per MBMC Member Boat. The target species of this tournament are marlin. The heaviest single marlin in each Division will collect the \$100 1st Place Prize. Tournament Points will be awarded to each Member and Member Boat submitting either weigh slips or release slips.

Tuesday September 1, 2010, fishing starts at 12:01 AM and continues all month until Wednesday, September 30, 2010. Final weigh-in is required no later than 6:00 pm September 30, 2010, at the Dana Landing dock.

Tournament entry fees will be collected at Dana Landing Market & Fuel Dock. Entries must be submitted at Dana Landing or faxed to 858-292-7952, **prior to fishing**, and must be paid in full by 6:00pm, on Wednesday, September 30th to remain eligible for the tournament.

In the event of weather conditions and/or any other potential reason to cancel or postpone the tournament, a message will be left on the MBMC message machine at 619-224-8862. The decision will be made by the board no later than 9:00 pm the day before the tournament and put on the message machine as well as posted on the web site. Please check either the message line and/or the web site if conditions look questionable. M.B. Lifeguard current weather conditions and warnings can be heard at 619-221-8824.

THE 2010 ROY LIVELY MONTH-LONG MARLIN TOURNAMENT RULES

1. Tournament will be during the month of September, commencing Tuesday September 1, 2010, fishing starts at 12:01 AM and continues during the month until Wednesday September 30, 2010, at 6:00 pm. All participants are eligible to fish any of those days.
 2. Tournament entry fees of **\$50 per boat with no angler fees** will be collected at Dana Landing Market and Fuel Dock. All entries must be submitted to Dana Landing, **prior to fishing** in person, or faxed to 858-549-0604.
 3. **All anglers, members and non-members, on any Club Boat which paid to participate are eligible.** Additional anglers may be added to qualified entered boats at any time, provided a completed entry form is submitted at Dana Landing in person, or faxed to 858-292-7952, **prior to fishing**. Only fish caught or released on paid boat will qualify.
 4. Fishing area is from San Martin Island to the south and San Miguel Island to the north.
 5. The target species of this tournament are **marlin only**.
 6. I.G.F.A. rules will apply to tackle and method of take.
 7. You must be in the Dana Landing Basin and be visible from the weigh-in dock by tournament end at **6:00 PM on September 30, 2010**, for your catch to count.
 8. Top boat shall be decided by the member boat with the most points. One pound = 1 point for weighed in fish. Released fish = 150 points. Top Angler in each division (Men's, Women's, and Juniors) shall be decided by the total points for **the largest single fish submitted during the tourney**. In the case of a tie (only Releases submitted or exact weight), a random drawing will be held to determine 1st, 2nd, and 3rd places using one chance per submitted fish. **A released fish must be photographed and CLEARLY DEPICT THE MARLIN AND LEADER IN HAND. The completed release form & photograph must be turned in to the MBMC weighmaster within 10 days of the release, and you must notify the club within 36 hours of the release, by radio, telephone or fax with all of the information that is included on the release form, to qualify for points or any awards.**
 9. Scoring: 4 points for first place, 3 for second, 2 for third, and one point for a fish weighed in of the targeted species. These points accumulate for all MBMC tournaments open to all members for the angling year 2009. A maximum of 9 tournaments will determine the total score for each angler and boat. A minimum of 5 tournaments during the year must be fished to be in contention for the top boat or angler.
 10. Radio Communications will be on Channel 69. The club and other boats can be contacted on this channel.
 11. You are responsible for having all the necessary California Fishing Licenses and Mexican Fishing Permits when fishing California and/or Mexican waters. You should also be aware of the laws governing the number and size of fish in your possession.
 12. All protests must be received in writing no later than one hour after final weigh-in and will be reviewed by the Protest Committee for validity.
 13. Tournament results will be posted soon after final weigh in. Awards will be presented at one of the following club events.
- Payouts will be \$100 for 1st Place in each division (Top Male, Top Female, Top Junior, and Top Boat).

With the weather starting to warm up, we're expecting record participation and looking forward to seeing the faces of Southern California's fishing community! Because this tournament weekend coincides with the Heart Marlin Tournament, members will be eligible to participate in both events, subject to both tournaments rules.

This year the tournament will be going back to a **multiple line class** event. 20lb and 30lb test will be used with more points for the lighter line. This has always added more excitement to the event and we look forward to that.

The ILTT formally began in 1959 when, following a two-year Albacore drought, the Marlin Club suggested the spirit of the Albacore tournament live on in the form of light tackle Marlin fishing. It was a triumph, with approximately 1,100 Marlin weighed in that year. The event has continued to be one of the premier fishing tournaments in Southern California ever since!

A little trivia: At the tournament's inception, a controversial rule was proposed by the tackle committee to allow the use of Monofilament and Dacron lines, and "other synthetic lines that might be manufactured *in the future*." The foresight was significant, especially because linen line was most commonly used at the time and required very special handling.

Please join us in carrying on the traditions of this historic event. We look forward to sharing the weekend with you!
