It's now the first week in June and we're still waiting for some decent weather to settle in so we can get some good consistently clean water conditions which will help put the fish on the bite for more than 1-2 days at a time. It's been frustrating so far ; last month the yellows showed up on the Rockpile and one of the Sporties put 100 fish on the deck for 27 guys @ midweek; Mike Bratton was able to get on it the next day with 4 buddies and they took 9 and lost 5-6; many went the following day for nothing and the weather was up. They're still in hiding. The La Jolla White Sea Bass Bite has flickered on and off for very select few as the squid has not shown up yet in big numbers. And our Halibut season hasn't really begun yet except for new Board Member and OOPSLINE Editor Tony Sanfilippo; he's had a fair amount of success on the edges of the La Jolla Kelp landing quite a few in the 15-30# range and would probably be an F.O.M. winner by now if he would remember to weigh them in on a *certified scale*. He's put many pictures up on our Blackman Website but the rules are a little looser there. It's been a year now since John Pye and Madeline Rooney had their epic catch aboard the Menu and really got our season started; there were a couple of nice butts taken in last month's Halibut / White Sea Bass Tourney but the WSB were absent; Brent Hargraves aboard his dad's boat RADAR took the largest fish of the tourney, a 21.6 pound flattie. Lance Fisher took a 15# butt off the Lively One for second place and Tony Sanfilippo's honey hole gave up a 13.5 to take 3<sup>rd</sup> Place. Rich Cassillas landed an 8.8# halibut aboard the Sublimely Hooked and once again the Rachel was able to squeeze 22 inches out of a 3.4 pound butt to earn Boat Points.

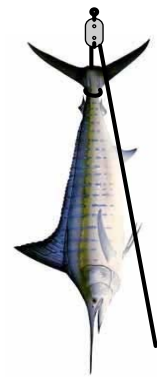
On May 6<sup>th</sup>, the Lively One, Sublimely Hooked, and Doghouse entered the Southwestern Yacht Club's Bottomfish Tourney with hopes of representing our club well and getting a chance at regaining the Perpetual Trophy. It really couldn't have worked out any better as we took 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> place Boat, 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> place Male Angler and 1<sup>st</sup> place Women's Angler. Tony Sanfilippo took the biggest cod @ 6.8 pounds and Russ Hughes was second with a 6.5; however since they were both on the Doghouse only Tony would get the \$300 cash prize. Jeff Lyons on the Lively One cashed in Second place money with a 6.2 cod; and Denise Huff won the Women's Division aboard the Sublimely Hooked with a 6# cod. Doghouse and Lively One finished 1 & 2 respectively thus winning the Club Trophy. We all struck out at the raffle however as one table of SWYC Members took home 80% of the prizes; it was fun to hear the rest of the crowd cheer when that table *didn't* win the raffle prize! Once again, they served a great breakfast and dinner benefitting the San Diego Hospice.

Our next tourney is the Calico, Sand, and Spotted Bay Bass Tourney on June 25 & 26 with the Captain's meeting Friday night June 24<sup>th</sup>. Bonus points with Spotted Bay Bass and awards will be based on highest point value not weight. And just around the corner is the annual MBMC Luau back @ Mariner's Point this year on Saturday July 23<sup>rd</sup> so please save the date. We'll have the usual contests and prizes, great Polynesian food and Larry Oberti's fabulous Mai Tai Bar which made my head spin last year! Same costs as last year, \$20 for adult members and non-members, juniors 16 and under are free with a paid adult. I'd really like to see a nice crowd at the Luau, the season is starting to heat up and the fishing will pick up soon, do your part and support your club by attending as many of the Club's events as you can. Summer is here it's time to Party!

# 2011 MBMC BASS TOURNAMENT ENTRY FORM

**JUNE 25 AND 26, 2011**

Entry fees are \$13.00 per MBMC member, \$20.00 per guest. An optional \$5.00 cash jackpot fee will be collected from those who wish to participate. The heaviest **SINGLE BASS, Calico, Sand or Spotted Bay Bass** of the tournament will collect the optional jackpot.

Saturday JUNE 25, 2011, fishing starts at 12:01 AM and continues until you can make the weigh in at 6:00 PM at the Dana Landing dock. Fish not weighed in by the 6:00 PM deadline on Saturday June 25 will be weighed in Sunday when the scales are open.

Sunday JUNE 26, 2011, fishing continues for this tournament and final weigh-in's are required no later than 6:00PM at the Dana Landing dock.

Tournament entry fees will be collected at Dana Landing Market & Fuel Dock. All entries must be submitted by 18:00 pm, Friday JUNE 24, 2011 at Dana Landing, in person at the captains meeting by 20:00, or faxed to the tournament chairman at 858-292-7952

In the event of weather conditions and/or any other potential reason to cancel or postpone the tournament, a message will be left on the MBMC message machine at 619-224-8229. The decision will be made by the board no later than 25:00 pm the day before the tournament and put on the message machine as well as posted on the web site. Please check either the message line and/or the web site if conditions look questionable.

## **2011 CALICO, SAND, AND SPOTTED BAY BASS Tournament Rules**

1. Tournament will be two days, commencing Saturday JUNE 25, 2011 @ 12:01 AM and ending @ 6:00 PM Sunday JUNE 26, 2011. All participants are eligible to fish either or both days.
2. Tournament entry fees will be collected at Dana Landing Market and Fuel Dock. All entries must be submitted by 8:00 PM, Friday JUNE 24, 2011 at Dana Landing, in person at the Friday night Captains Seminar, or faxed to the tournament chairman at 858-292-7952.
3. **All entries not paid at time of sign-up must be paid in full by 6:00 PM, on Sunday JUNE 26, 2011 to remain eligible for remaining tournaments and awards. ONE individual participant substitution per tournament is allowed. ALL anglers on board will be entered and paid up for the boat total to count. Additional anglers can be called in to the club on Channel 69 between the hours of 12 noon and 6pm on the day of their participation.**
4. Fishing area is from San Martin Island to the south and San Miguel Island to the north.
5. I.G.F.A. rules will apply to tackle and method of take.
6. Weigh in time is from 12:00 PM to 6:00 PM Saturday and 12:00PM to 6:00PM Sunday. You must be in the Dana Landing Basin and be visible from the weigh-in dock by 6:00 PM Sunday.
7. Top boat shall be decided by the boat with the LARGEST POINT TOTAL of their top 3 fish of the tournament species. The species targeted in this tournament are **CALICO, SAND AND SPOTTED BAY BASS**. Spotted Bay Bass will have a 2 point per pound diversity advantage.
8. Radio Communications will be on Channel 69. The club and other boats can be contacted on this channel.
9. Scoring: 4 points for first place angler with most point total target fish, 3 for second, 2 for third, and one point for a fish weighed in of the targeted species. These points accumulate for all MBMC tournaments open to all members for the angling year 2011. A maximum 8 of 9 tournaments will determine the total score for each angler and boat. A minimum of 5 tournaments during the year must be fished to be in contention for the top boat or angler.
10. You are responsible for having all the necessary California Fishing Licenses and Mexican Fishing Permits when fishing California and/or Mexican waters. You should also be aware of the laws governing the number and size of fish in your possession.
11. All protests must be received in writing no later than one hour after final weigh-in and will be reviewed by the Protest Committee for validity.
12. Tournament results will be posted soon after final weigh in on Sunday. Tournament awards for First second and third top anglers will be in the form of Cash Voucher Cards at Dana Landing Tackle and can be picked up there by the Wednesday following the tournament. The Side pot award will be in the form of a check from MBMC and will also be available at the Dana Landing Tackle Store desk. Member awards will be awarded at the annual Awards Meeting in January of 2012.
13. Payouts for first, second, and third place will be based on a percentage of the total amount of entry fees collected. All participants are eligible for these awards including members, guests, and Juniors.

## **Po' Man's Lobster**

**Special thanks to Jeff Meeker for this recipe!**

1-2# Halibut cut into 1" Cubes

1 gallon water in a tall pan

½ cup sea salt

½ cup sugar

½ stick real butter

Take 1 gallon of water, 1/2 cup of Sea Salt, and 1/2 cup of sugar and mix them while bringing the water to boil. Once the water boils, drop the fish cubes in the pot and cook for 7-7 1/2 minutes and then remove the cubes and place them on a plate with toothpicks. Melt 1/4-1/2 stick real butter in the microwave and then dip the fish individually, you won't believe it ! One pound of fish works with half the water, sugar, and salt.
