Even though there are still a few small yellowtail, dorado, and bluefin tuna to be had below San Quintin @ 150 miles, we're definitely in the Fall season with a few halibut and mostly rockfish in the counts now, as evident in our last tournament the What's Hot which turned into a potpourri event where anything goes except sharks or rays.

Our own Tournament Director Jerry Lively led the pack after the first day with a 24# halibut caught out in front followed by Donna McKee's 19.8# halibut off PB; Day 2 saw the Scott's Johnny going back out after catching a 16# total of rockfish off the 9 mile bank on Saturday to where they saw the others fishing late Saturday afternoon and pounding the sand and eventually seeing Mike Bratton landing a 23.9# butt to take 2nd Place Male and Top Boat too. Donna's fish got her 1st Place Female and Max Dumstorff's 4.8 rockcod led him to Top Junior points for the Tournament. We were supposed to have a drawing at the last Captain's Meeting to determine the Top Male winner in the September Month Long Marlin Tourney between Shawn Kaus, John Ashley, and Kevin Bohannon. Personally I'm rooting for Shawn as his release did not coincide with another tourney; Kevin's release won him the Grand Prize East Cape Fishing Package in our Heart Tournament while John Ashley's fish won the Top Prize in the Make-A-Wish Tuna Challenge sending John & Millie in the opposite direction up to Alaska on a \$10,000 Fishing Lodge Expedition. John's fish also gave Mission Bay Marlin Club the Top Club Award as well. We put the 3 anglers names in a hat at our monthly Board Meeting; and John Ashley won the Top Male Angler and a check for \$100.

That's the good news for the month, here's the not so good; as mentioned in the last OOPSLINE, longtime member Jim Kanouse finally lost his battle with cancer earlier in the month. Jim was an active, true sportsman and he will be missed by all who knew him. Our heartfelt thoughts go out to his wife Judy and the rest of his family.

The latest angler backed lawsuit concerning the Southern California MLPA Plan was denied this month paving the way for a DFG planned implementation date of January 1st, 2011. Unless another course of action is brought upon this new regulation, prepare for congestion at the Kelp Beds off Northwest La Jolla, forget about those halibut spots above the border and the tremendous calico bass fishing off south La Jolla and Encinitas/Leucadia. I have a feeling an 11th hour lawsuit will be coming up over the Holidays, you can still support USAC with a donation to help fight the battle.

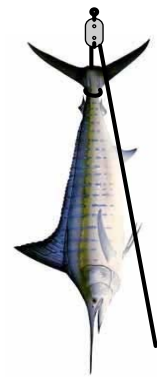

NOVEMBER 12 AND 13, 2011

Entry fees are \$15.00 per MBMC member, \$20.00 per guest. An optional \$5.00 cash jackpot fee will be collected from those who wish to participate. The heaviest **SINGLE LING COD** of the tournament will collect the optional jackpot.

Saturday NOVEMBER 12, 2011, fishing starts at 12:01 AM and continues until you can make the weigh in at 6:00 PM at the Dana Landing dock. Fish not weighed in by the 6:00 PM deadline on Saturday November 12 be weighed in Sunday when the scales are open.

Sunday NOVEMBER 13, 2011, fishing continues for this tournament and final weigh-in's are required no later than 6:00PM at the Dana Landing dock.

Tournament entry fees will be collected at Dana Landing Market & Fuel Dock. All entries must be submitted by 18:00 pm, Friday NOVEMBER 11, 2011 at Dana Landing, in person at the captains meeting by 20:00, or faxed to the tournament chairman at 858-292-7952

In the event of weather conditions and/or any other potential reason to cancel or postpone the tournament, a message will be left on the MBMC message machine at 619-224-8229. The decision will be made by the board no later than 16:00 pm the day before the tournament and put on the message machine as well as posted on the web site. Please check either the message line and/or the web site if conditions look questionable.

2011 Ling Cod Tournament Rules

1. Tournament will be two days, commencing Saturday NOV. 12, 2011 @ 12:01 AM and ending @ 6:00 PM Sunday NOV. 13, 2011. All participants are eligible to fish either or both days.
2. Tournament entry fees will be collected at Dana Landing Market and Fuel Dock. All entries must be submitted by 8:00 PM, Friday NOV. 11, 2011 at Dana Landing, in person, or faxed to the tournament chairman at 858-292-7952.
3. **All entries not paid at time of sign-up must be paid in full by 6:00 PM, on Sunday NOV. 13, 2011 to remain eligible for the tournament awards. If delinquent after tournament, entry will be denied into other tournaments until restitution is paid.**
4. Fishing area is from San Martin Island to the south and San Miguel Island to the north.
5. I.G.F.A. rules will apply to tackle and method of take.
6. Weigh in time is from 12:00 PM to 6:00 PM Saturday and 12:00PM to 6:00PM Sunday. You must be in the Dana Landing Basin and be visible from the weigh-in dock by 6:00 PM.
7. Top boat shall be decided by the boat with the HEAVIEST WEIGHT of their top 3 fish of the tournament species. The species targeted in this tournament is **LING COD**. There will be no point multiplier applied for any species in this tournament.
8. Radio Communications will be on Channel 69. The club and other boats can be contacted on this channel.
9. Scoring: 4 points for first place angler with heaviest target fish, 3 for second, 2 for third, and one point for a fish weighed in of the targeted species. These points accumulate for all MBMC tournaments open to all members for the angling year 2011. A maximum 8 of 9 tournaments will determine the total score for each angler and boat. A minimum of 5 tournaments during the year must be fished to be in contention for the top boat or angler.
10. You are responsible for having all the necessary California Fishing Licenses and Mexican Fishing Permits when fishing California and/or Mexican waters. You should also be aware of the laws governing the number and size of fish in your possession. Also be aware of the **IMPORT Documentation** necessary for bringing game fish into California Waters from Mexico Waters.
11. All protests must be received in writing no later than one hour after final weigh-in and will be reviewed by the Pro-test Committee for validity.
12. Tournament results will be posted soon after final weigh in on Sunday. Awards will be presented at the next social event.
13. Payouts for first, second, and third place will be based on a percentage of the total amount of entry fees collected.
14. **Optional Cash Jackpot:** A voluntary \$5 cash jackpot per person entry is available to enter, however all anglers fishing on the same boat except Junior Anglers must be entered in order to qualify for the winner-take-all largest fish cash jackpot
