Fishing continues Sunday March 22, 2009 for this tournament and final weigh-in's are required no later than 6:00 pm at the Dana Landing Dock.

Tournament entry fees & forms will be collected at Dana Landing Market & Fuel Dock. All entries must be submitted by 8:00 pm on March 20,2009 at Dana Landing, or in person.
