SPECIES SPECIFIC MONTH LONG TOURNAMENT RULES

New! - MBMC Month Long Tournament (Species Specific)

1. This is a Species Specific Tournament, species to be named prior to the contest start date by Email and MBMC Website.

The Contest begins the 1st. Day of Each Month and Ends the Last Day of the Month.

This is a Winner Take All - Largest Fish Cash Jackpot Tournament (less administrative tournament fees - amount will vary).

2. The Entry Fee of \$30.00 USD per Angler participating in the Month Long Tournament Must be Mailed to:

Entries must be received before the fish is landed and weighed to be eligible in the Tournament

(Once a Paypal Account is set up, Anglers may Pay the Entry Fee Online)

Paypal account will be on the Mission Bay Marlin Club website.

3. All Fish must be caught in accordance with the MBMC Club Rules and Regulations. IGFA Rules apply to all fish caught. California Department of Fish and Wildlife Rules and Regulations Apply.

4. The Tournament is Open to All MBMC Members, Family, and Friends. All Fish Must be caught aboard a recreational MBMC Members Boat, by an Angler participating in the (Month Long Tournament). **No commercial boat of any type will be allowed to enter**

5. The Fishing Area for the MBMC shall be limited to those waters of the Pacific Ocean lying between a line running due East and West (true) from the southern tip of San Martin Island on the south and a similar line running due East and West (true) from the northern tip of San Miguel Island on the north.

6.1 All Fish entered in the (Month Long Tournament) may be Weighed at MBMC or any weigh station listed below.

6.2 A Certificate of Weight must be filed with the MBMC Weigh Master within three (3) days of date of catch.

Certificate, photo of fish, gear and angler can be submitted via email, text or filed at Dana Landing Market. File is tended by Dana Landing fuel dock personnel. **Email address: events@missionbaymarlinclub.org**

6.3 The angler who caught the fish must present with the tackle used for the catch at the time of weigh in. Any protest relative to weight of fish or manner of weighing must be made before fish is removed from the scale. Any protest relative to tackle or method of taking the fish must be made in writing by a member and must be filed with the secretary within 72 hours from the time the weigh certificate was filed with the MBMC Weigh Master.

7. You are responsible for having all the necessary California Fishing Licenses and Mexican Fishing Permits when fishing California and/or Mexican waters.

8. Tournament results to be posted on MBMC Website soon after Final Weigh in and last day of contest.

9. Payout for Winner will be based on a percentage of total amount of entry fees collected (less administrative fees).

10. Optional \$10 Cash Jackpot has 100% Payout to Winning Angler.
