

2020 WHAT'S HOT (Any Fish) Tournament Rules

1. Tournament will be two days, commencing Saturday October 24, 2020 @ 12:01 AM and ending @ 6:00 PM Sunday October 25, 2020. All participants are eligible to fish either or both days.
2. Tournament entry fees will be collected at Dana Landing Market and Fuel Dock. All entries must be submitted by 6:00 PM, Friday October 23, 2020 at Dana Landing or at the Club mailbox.
3. All fishing shall be in accordance with IGFA and Club rules; and California and Mexican regulations.
4. Weigh in time is from 12:00 PM to 6:00 PM Saturday and 12:00PM to 6:00PM Sunday. You must be in the Dana Landing Basin and be visible from the weigh-in dock by 6:00 PM Sunday.
5. Top boat for each division (Male, Female, Junior) shall be decided by the boat with the LARGEST GAMEFISH WEIGHED for a given division. The species targeted in this tournament **any gamefish**. Sharks, rays & skates are non-qualifiers.

Any Marlin released will count for 150 points. In comparison, any gamefish weighed (whether it be Marlin or any other qualifying gamefish) will be counted at one point per pound. For example, a 170 pound weighed Marlin or Tuna will be worth 170 points and will beat out a 150 point Marlin release.

*****Important!!!** A qualifying Marlin release MUST be accompanied by the standard photo to include hand on leader with the fish in the background.

All Marlin release catches will be ranked based on time of release. First release will rank higher than subsequent releases and so on down the line. .

6. Boat Scoring: Due to a lack of qualifying tournament events for the 2020 season, there will be no accumulated boat points awarded for this year's tournament.
7. All protests must be received in writing no later than 24 hours after final weigh-in and will be reviewed by the Protest Committee for validity.
8. Tournament results will be posted soon after final weigh in on Sunday on the Club Website. Tournament awards will be in the form of Cash Voucher Cards, presented at the next social event.
9. Payouts will be 100% of entries for both Men and Women's divisions and Juniors will also be 100% of their entries.

A tiered payout will be used:

- 1st place = 50%

- 2nd place = 30%

- 3rd place = 20%
