

2022 HALIBUT / WHITE SEABASS Tournament Rules

1. Tournament will be two days, commencing Saturday May 21, 2022 @ 12:01 a.m. and ending @ 6:00 p.m. Sunday May 22, 2022. All participants are eligible to fish either or both days.
2. All Entry Forms will be submitted to info@missionbaymarlinclub.org. All entries must be submitted by 6:00 p.m., Friday May 20, 2022. Members may take a camera photo or scan the form to email in. Tournament entry fees will be collected at Dana Landing Market and Fuel Dock. All fees are due by Sunday, May 22 @ 8 p.m.
3. All fishing shall be in accordance with IGFA and Club rules; as well as California and Mexican regulations.
4. Weigh in time is from 12:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. Saturday and 12:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. Sunday. You must be in the Dana Landing Basin and be visible from the weigh-in dock by 6:00 p.m. Sunday deadline.
5. Winner will be for the largest qualifying fish in each division (Adult & Jr.). Qualifying fish only include **Halibut or White Seabass**.
6. Top boat shall be decided by the boat with the LARGEST POINT TOTAL of their top 3 fish of the tournament species. The species targeted in this tournament are **Halibut and White Seabass**.
7. Top Boat Scoring: 3 pts. for first place, 2 pts. for second, 1 pt. for third. These points accumulate for all MBMC tournaments open to all member boats for the angling year 2022. The boat with the most points at the end of the year will be awarded the Top Boat Award.
8. All protests must be received in writing no later than 24 hours after final weigh-in and will be reviewed by the Protest Committee for validity.
9. Tournament results will be posted the week after final weigh in on Sunday on the Club Website. Tournament awards will be in the form of Dana Landing Gift Cards, presented at the next social event or via an agreed upon method.
10. Payouts will be 100% of entries for both Adult and Junior's divisions. Top Boat is a year-end award and there will be no pay out in the Tournament.
11. There will also be an additional \$50 Dana Landing Gift Card to the winner of each of the two divisions.
12. In the event that no qualifying fish are caught in a division, the entry fees will be refunded to all who participated. The \$50 gift cards will be randomly raffled off to the division participants.
