

2022 MBMC TUNA Tournament Rules

1. Tournament will be two days, commencing Saturday June 25, 2022 @ 12:01 AM and ending @ 6:00 PM Sunday June 26, 2022. All participants are eligible to fish either or both days.
2. **All Entry Forms must be submitted to info@missionbaymarlinclub.org.** Dealine for Entry submittals is 6:00 p.m., Friday June 24, 2022. Members may take a camera photo or scan the form to email in. Tournament entry fees will be collected at Dana Landing Market and Fuel Dock (MBMC Folder behind the counter, anyone at the register can assist). All fees are due by Sunday, June 26 @ 8 p.m.
3. All fishing shall be in accordance with IGFA and Club rules; and California and Mexican regulations.
4. Weigh in time is from 12:00 PM to 6:00 PM Saturday and 12:00PM to 6:00 PM Sunday. You must be in the Dana Landing Basin and be visible from the weigh-in dock by 6:00 PM Sunday.
5. **Weigh slips must be submitted by emailing a scan or image to info@missionbaymarlinclub.org.** Submittal deadline is Sunday, June 26 @ 8 p.m. Following this, records will be confirmed at the Dana Fuel Dock.
6. Top boat shall be decided by the boat with the largest aggregate weight of their top 3 fish of the tournament species. The species targeted in this tournament are **Tuna (Yellowfin, Bluefin and Bigeye) as well as Yellowtail.**
7. Boat Scoring: 3 points for first place, 2 for second, 1 for third. These points accumulate for all MBMC tournaments open to all members for the angling year 2022. The boat with the most points at the end of the year will be awarded the Top Boat.
8. Divisional Payout Awards and Side Pot will be based on the heaviest single fish of the qualifying species.
9. All protests must be received in writing no later than 24 hours after final weigh-in and will be reviewed by the Protest Committee for validity.
10. Tournament results will be posted the week after final weigh in on Sunday on the Club Website. Tournament awards will be in the form of Dana Landing Gift Cards, presented at the next social event or via an agreed upon method.
11. For Payouts to occur, there needs to be a minimum of TWO (2) Entrants in the Men's and Women's Divisions.
12. Payouts will be the following:
 - Men's Division: 1st Place - \$150 + 100% Divisional Entry Payout
 - Women's Division: 1st Place - \$150 + 100% Divisional Entry Payout
 - Junior Division: 1st Place - \$50 + 100% Divisional Entry Payout
 - Yellowtail Side Pot: 1st Place - (100% payout)
 - Top Boat is a year-end award and there will be no pay out.
