

## 2019 Roy Lively MONTH LONG Tournament Rules

1. Tournament will be for the month of September, commencing September 1, 2019 @ 12:01 AM and ending @ 6:00 PM September 30, 2019. All participants are eligible to fish any day during the month.
2. Tournament entry fees will be collected at Dana Landing Market and Fuel Dock. All entries must be submitted prior to fishing at Dana Landing or at the Club mailbox.
3. All fishing shall be in accordance with IGFA and Club rules; and California and Mexican regulations.
4. You must be in the Dana Landing Basin and be visible from the weigh-in dock by 6:00 PM September 30, 2019 with your fish or release slip and documentation for a marlin to count on the last day of the tournament.
5. Anglers entered in the tournament may fish on any member's boat that is entered in the tournament.
6. Top boat will be decided by the member boat with the most points. One point per pound for weighed in fish. Released fish will count for 150 points. Top angler in Men's, Women's, and Juniors Division will be decided by the total points for the LARGEST SINGLE FISH SUBMITTED during the tournament. In the case of a tie a random drawing will be held to determine the winner using one chance per submitted fish. Top boat shall be decided by the boat with the LARGEST POINT TOTAL. The species targeted in this tournament is only **MARLIN**.
7. Boat Scoring: 3 points for first place, 2 for second, 1 for third. These points accumulate for all MBMC tournaments open to all members for the angling year 2019. The boat with the most points at the end of the year will be awarded the Top Boat.
8. All protests must be received in writing no later than 24 hours after final weigh-in and will be reviewed by the Protest Committee for validity.
9. Tournament results will be posted soon after final weigh in on the Club Website. Tournament awards will be in the form of Cash Voucher Cards, presented at the next social event.
10. Payouts will be 80% of entries for both Men and Women's divisions and Juniors will be 100% of their entries. Top Boat is a year-end award and there will be no pay out.
