2024 Halibut / Whiteseabass MONTH LONG Tournament Rules

1. Tournament will be for the month of May, commencing May 1, 2024 @ 12:01 AM and ending @ 6:00 PM May 31, 2024. All Entrants are eligible to fish any day during the month.
2. All entries must be submitted prior to fishing.
3. All fishing shall be in accordance with IGFA and Club rules; and California and Mexican regulations.
4. Anglers entered in the tournament may fish on any MEMBER'S BOAT that is entered in the tournament.
5. California Halibut and Whiteseabass are the only qualifying fish for this Tournament.
6. Qualifying fish must be weighed in at the Dana Landing Fuel Dock scales or another IGFA Certified weigh station. A certified Weigh Slip must be filled out by the Staff. Retain a copy for your records. Only Weigh Slips dated for the month of May will qualify. **Submit via photo or scan image to info@missionbaymarlinclub.org. Submittals are due within three (3) days of catch.**
7. MBMC Award Plaques will be awarded for the single LARGEST qualifying fish weighed in the Adult and Junior Categories.
8. Top boat shall be decided by the boat with the LARGEST WEIGHT TOTAL of their top 3 fish of the Tournament Species. Only Halibut & Whiteseabass count toward the top boat award.
9. Boat Scoring: 4 pts. for First Place, 3 for Second, 2 for Third, & 1 for Entering (if not in top 3). These points accumulate for all MBMC Tournaments open to all members for the 2023 Angling Year. The boat with the most points at the end of the year will be awarded the Top Boat Award.
10. All protests must be received in writing no later than 24 hours after final weigh-in and will be reviewed by the Protest Committee for validity.
