June 1, 2024, fishing starts at 12:01 AM and continues until you can make the weigh in at 6:00 PM on June 30, 2024 at the Dana Landing dock.

## 2024 MBMC Yellowtail MONTH LONG Tournament Rules

- 1. Tournament will be for the month of June, commencing June 1, 2024 @ 12:01 AM and ending @ 6:00 PM Sunday June 30, 2024. All Entrants are eligible to fish any day during the month.
- 2. All entry forms must be submitted prior to fishing. Tournament entry fees will be collected at Dana Landing Market or at the MBMC mailbox.
- 3. All fishing shall be in accordance with IGFA and Club rules; and California and Mexican regulations.
- 4. Qualifying Yellowtail must be weighed in at the Dana Landing Fuel Dock or another IGFA Certified weigh station. A certified Weigh Slip must be filled out by the Staff. Retain a copy for your records. Only Weigh Slips dated for the month of June will qualify. Submit via photo or scan image to info@missionbaymarlinclub.org. Submittals are due within three (3) days of catch.
- 5. MBMC Award Plaques will be awarded for the SINGLE heaviest yellowtail in each Division (Adults & Junior) along with 100% payout of entry fees for that Division.
- 6. Top boat shall be decided by the boat with the LARGEST WEIGHT TOTAL of their top 3 fish of the Tournament Species. Only Yellowtail count toward the top boat award.
- 7. Boat Scoring: 4 pts. for First Place, 3 for Second, 2 for Third, & 1 for Entering (if not in top 3). These points accumulate for all MBMC Tournaments open to all members for the 2023 Angling Year. The boat with the most points at the end of the year will be awarded Top Boat Award.
- 8. All protests must be received in writing no later than 24 hours after final weigh-in and will be reviewed by the Protest Committee for validity.
