

2024 MBMC ROCKCOD / LINGCOD TOURNAMENT ENTRY FORM

November 16 and 17, 2024

Entry fees are \$30.00 per MBMC member, \$40.00 per guest and \$10 per junior. <u>There will also be</u> an optional Lingcod Side Pot \$25 per Angler. See below for award breakdown:

- Adult Division Rockcod: 1st Place \$225, 2nd Place \$125, 3rd Place \$75
- Junior Division Rockcod: 1st Place \$75
- Lingcod Side Pot: 1st Place (100% payout of side pot entries)

Awards will be based on the heaviest single fish of the qualifying species (Rockcod or Lingcod (Side Pot))

Saturday November 16, 2024, fishing starts at 12:01 AM and continues until you can make the weigh in deadline at 6:00 PM on Sunday November 17, 2024 at the Dana Landing dock.

2024 MBMC ROCKFISH/LINGCOD Tournament Rules

Tournament will be two days, commencing Saturday November 16, 2024 @ 12:01 AM and continues until the weigh in deadline @ 6:00 PM Sunday November 17, 2024. All participants are eligible to fish either or both days.

All entries must be submitted by 6:00 p.m., Friday November 15, 2024.Tournament entry fees will be collected at Dana Landing Market or MBMC Mailbox. All fees are due by Sunday, November 17 @ 8 p.m.

All fishing shall be in accordance with IGFA and Club rules; and California and Mexican regulations.

You must be in the Dana Landing Basin and be visible from the weigh-in dock by 6:00 PM Sunday.

Qualifying Rockfish / Lingcod must be weighed in at the Dana Landing Fuel Dock or another IGFA Certified Weigh Station. A certified Weigh Slip must be filled out by the Staff. Retain a copy for your records. **Submit via photo or scan image to info@missionbaymarlinclub.org. Submittals are due by Sunday, November 19 @ 8 p.m.**

Heaviest single Cod in each category will win the prize. Single heaviest Lingcod will win the Side Pot award.

Top boat shall be decided by the boat with the LARGEST WEIGHT TOTAL of their top 3 fish of the tournament species. Only Rockfish count towards the top boat award. Lingcod are NOT included in the top boat weight. Top Boat is a year-long accumulation of Tournament points.

Boat Scoring: 4 points for first place, 3 for second, 2 for third, & 1 for Entering (if not in top 3). These points accumulate for all MBMC tournaments open to all members for the 2023 angling year. The boat with the most points at the end of the year will be awarded the Top Boat Award.

All protests must be received in writing no later than 24 hours after final weigh-in and will be reviewed by the Protest Committee for validity.

Tournament results will be posted the week after the final weigh in. All Tournament awards will be paid by MBMC Check and will be presented via the best method possible as agreed with the winners.

^{***&}lt;u>ALL</u> anglers/crew on the boat during the fishing day must be entered in the tournament. If an angler is entered in the Lingcod division on a vessel, then the same rule applies that <u>ALL</u> anglers/crew on the boat must also be entered in the Lingcod jackpot division.
